FROM THE TABLE



As part of our Lenten Journey together, we will be sharing in a special worship service on Sunday: **A Service of Hope and Healing.**

Over the last couple of years, we have shared Healing services after our regular Sunday

worship service. This type of worship has been a time when you can bring anything that concerns you, whether it's a physical ailment that stays with you or a deep grief you aren't able to let go of, to God and the gathered community, in prayer. This will be a variation on that worship service and will include the Lord's Supper, a reflection on Hope and Healing by our own Scot Crosslin, and a time for you to receive healing prayer from one of our elders.

What it means to find healing is different than what it means to find a cure. While our time spent in prayer, sharing our hopes, confessing our grief and brokenness with one another does not offer the same thing that medical treatment and science can offer our bodies, this time of Hope and Healing is a time when we can bring our hearts and minds—our very souls—to God, and God offers us a type of healing that allows us to welcome uncertain futures and outcomes, and allows us to forgive, whether it is a friend, an adversary, or ourselves that we need to forgive.
